

FACULTY OF MEDICINE

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Our Faculty admitted its first group of students in 2013, who have graduated in 2019. Our students receive training in our faculty building in the first three years and in the Ministry of Health Istanbul Medeniyet University Göztepe Training and Research Hospital in their last three years. Education is based on integrated curricula, which involves the application of learning methods such as Problem-Based Learning and Case-Based Learning which encourage our students to investigate and generate solutions to clinical problems. Students acquire clinical skills in our Clinical Skills Labs.

YOUNG AND DYNAMIC TEACHING STAFF

We have a strong, young and dynamic teaching staff. The number of faculty members is about 150 and exceeds 200 including the instructors of the Ministry. Our staff is increasingly getting stronger both in numbers and quality.



THE HOSPITAL

The current hospital building came into use in 1972 and Merdivenköy polyclinics in 1997. The hospital complex has a total closed area of 58 thousand square meters. Construction work for the new hospital building started in 2014 and has been planned to continue in two stages. The first stage is expected to come into service in 2019 with a total closed area of 258 thousand square meters, which means a growth of 4.5 fold. Total number of beds will rise from 640 to 1193. All patient rooms will be converted to "quality rooms" with one or two beds and a bathroom. Moreover, hospital and polyclinic services that are now offered in two different locations will then be in a single complex. Our new hospital has the characteristics of a "green building" and has been nominated for LEED for Health-care v2009 Gold certificate.

THE NEW FACULTY BUILDING PROJECT

A new faculty building integrated with the hospital is planned for construction. Thus, all faculty members, students, classrooms, laboratories, clinics, and clubs will be in the same campus. Having all the units of our Faculty inside the same complex will serve as a reinforcement to our training and research activities.



ACCREDITATION

In parallel with the increasing quality of medical training, we also have ongoing efforts toward accreditation, which will lead to an increase in student achievement and satisfaction. We are striving to quickly and successfully complete the process, to which we can apply following the graduation of our first alumni. One of the most significant benefits of accreditation is to increase the opportunities of our alumni to receive training and find employment abroad.

Furthermore, some of our clinics are already accredited nationally or internationally, while others have ongoing efforts toward getting accredited.



CENTRAL LOCATION

The central location of our Faculty and hospital provides convenience for our students. We are very close to all modes of transport including the metro, metrobus, Eurasian tunnel, buses, minibuses, and ferries.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Our students visit high quality centers abroad for training and research purposes. Similarly, we receive students and residents from abroad. We particularly have close relations with African countries. We conduct on-site and distance training programs in different countries.
